

QUADS HOUSE RULES



King Louie's Quads will use USA Volleyball Beach Doubles rules with Modified House Rules

- Best of 3 matches will consist of 2 sets to 21(cap 23), third set 15(cap 17) (No Caps in Tournament)
- No open hand tipping using "Finger Tip Action", Double Contacts are only permitted when a ball is hard driven with a downward trajectory or there is a short reaction time
- Do not set the serve, while it can technically be a legal touch it is too difficult of a judgement call for our refs to make, therefore all sets of the serve will be ruled a double contact
- Blocks do not count as a touch
- Rotating is not necessary except for service
- All players are considered front row
- Teams may play with minimum 2, maximum 4 players
- Penetration under the net is allowed provided you do not interfere with your opponent; the centerline is a neutral line that both offensive and defensive players can both occupy
- White Posts will act as the antenna, balls must be completely inside the posts to be in play
- Pursuit of the ball across the court past the center line is not allowed
- Teams have a five-minute grace period for each set before a forfeit. Teams are required to start on time if they have a minimum of 2 players present
- Players should play in leagues that coordinate with their level of play. Consistent Strong Hitters should play in A. Any player/team playing in a League that does not match their skill levels will be asked to move up, move down or move along.
- The Court/League Ball will be used unless both teams agree on using a different ball
- On Tournament Nights all players must have played a minimum of one league night. DO NOT STACK YOUR TEAM for TOURNAMENT NIGHT. No new subs are allowed for tournaments. If your team does not have any regular roster players or legal subs for tournament your team will need to forfeit. Players can only play on one team during tournament nights per court.
- For Safety of Everyone, do not enter any other court of play, if a player touches the line of another court the play will be blown dead, unless the nearby court is completely empty
- No Outside Alcohol, Pets, Glass, Tobacco(dipping/spitting) are allowed on the Premises
- Children are not allowed in any playable area of the court
- Please do not question the judgement of our referees, they are doing their best job to officiate the game. If there is any question concerning Rules or Referees judgement, please see Mike McCaskill
